


A happy Fuzzle plays with toys made by an elf.






Mini mushrats gather by the ticklish Toecat.








Rainbow bubbles lift the Hachie up for a chat.


Coloring by number is easy. Simply use the chart below to see which color you should use over the numbers above!

3 = Orange 7 = Purple






The slinky Slith plays with big bats at the day's end.


